

The vans cannot transport anyone experiencing serious medical problems, such as difficulty breathing, chest pain, serious burns or broken bones.

Any request for transport to the Emergency Room will be granted at the discretion of the Transportation Coordinator.

NRMC Transportation is provided under contract with CTS (District III Area Agency of Aging Coordinated Transportation Services). The drivers are employed by OATS and must meet their standards and follow their rules and regulations.

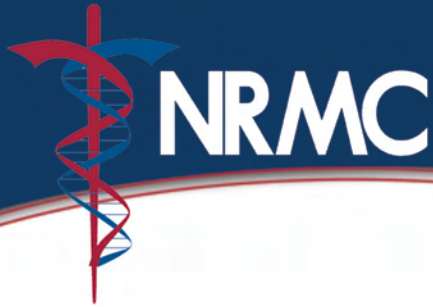

What is the transportation program?

The transportation program began in 1994 as the result of a federal grant to improve access to healthcare.

Since that time, thousands have benefited from the program.

The program has two wheelchair accessible vans. These two vans can hold up to ten people or two wheelchairs and six people. (A caregiver may accompany the patient and is required for those who require special assistance.)

Transportation can be arranged to any service of Nevada Regional Medical Center or to the office of any physician who is a member of the Active Medical Staff of NRMCM or visiting specialty physician. This includes Nevada Medical Clinic, the offices of Dr. Kemm, Dr. Beard, Dr. Lovinger and Dr. Compton.

Who is eligible?

Missouri residents in a 25 mile radius of Nevada are eligible. The transportation program cannot transport children under the age of 4 years or minors without a competent adult.

Is there any cost?

The transportation program is a free service provided by Nevada Regional Medical Center. Voluntary donations are gratefully accepted and help to keep the van running for those in need of transportation assistance. Suggested donations range from \$1-5.

No medical transportation will be denied based on a person's ability to pay.

How do I request transportation?

Signing up is easy. Just call (417) 448-3800. Information required will include your social security number, date of birth and Medicaid number if applicable. We ask that you give 24 hours notice of your appointment if possible.

We try very hard to accommodate everyone, but some unexpected delays may occur. We will do everything we can to pick you up as quickly as possible.

PLEASE BE ADVISED:

If your appointment runs past 4:30 p.m., it will be your responsibility to find another form of transportation home.

If Nevada Schools are cancelled due to bad weather, the vans will not operate.
